Shorter works, up to 6 pages, to be presented in 10 minutes, may be submitted as SHORT PAPERS representing work in progress or suggesting possible research directions. (Please, indicate "short paper" in the comments text-area in this case.) **All paper submissions will be done electronically, as indicated in the instructions on the conference web site [winnie.kuis.kyoto-u.ac.jp/IEAAIE-07/](http://winnie.kuis.kyoto-u.ac.jp/IEAAIE-07/). Paper submission is required by **November 8, 2006**. All papers must provide a key word list including one or more of the topics like those listed above.** ALL papers will be formally peer reviewed. Notification of the results of the review process will be made by **February 1, 2007**, and final copies of papers for inclusion in the conference proceedings will be due by **February 28, 2007**. The conference proceedings will be published in a bound volume by Springer-Verlag (the format is shown at <http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html>) in their 'Lecture Notes in Artificial Intelligence' series. Referees will be asked to nominate papers for a Best Paper award to be announced at the conference. All papers, but particularly those nominated for the Best Paper competition, will be automatically considered for publication in an expanded form in the International Journal of Applied Intelligence.
